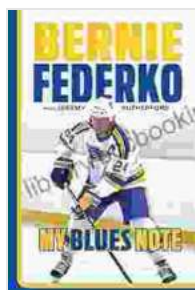

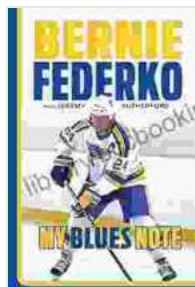

Bernie Federko is a retired professional hockey player and musician. He played 13 seasons in the NHL with the St. Louis Blues, and he was

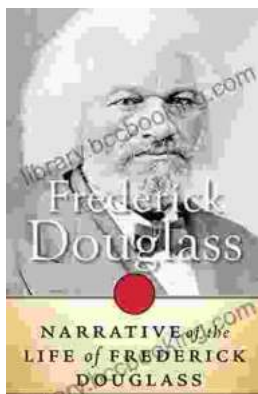
