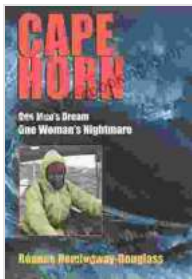


Cape Horn: One Man's Dream, One Woman's Nightmare

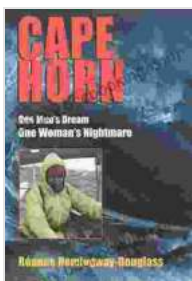

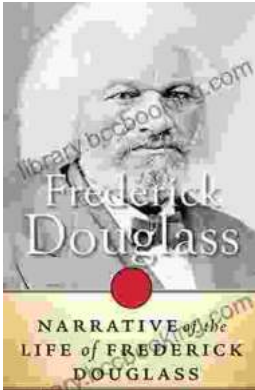
